1. Welcome and Agenda – G. Minney (slides 1-4)

The presentation has been updated with a Plan on a Page for 2023 (Slide 21). The updated pack will be distributed with these notes.

2. Actions - Chris Fleming (slides 5-6)

The actions from the previous meeting were reviewed as set out on slide 6.

Action 10.1 Blind Update Pseudo Script clarification – No further clarification required on the Pseudo Code Scripts. Action closed.

Action 10.2 AEMO to highlight in ongoing scope communication that CDR has 2 components – No further action required - Action closed.

There are no further outstanding actions.

3. November 22 Milestones – C. Fleming (slides 7-8)

AEM Development and internal testing is complete as per the presentation.

- Final versions of MSATS/B2B Go-Live Plan and CDR Go-Live Plan released.
- Confirmed CDR APIs will be available to Retailers in production for connectivity & performance testing from 2/11. It is unlikely that that DERR APIs will be available at go-live due to progress of NEL/NER amendments.
- Industry Testing Q&A sessions extended by 2 weeks

Action AEMO to send a CDR Go-Live Plan to forum members who have requested a copy but not yet received it.

4. MSDR Delivery Update – J. Agelopoulos (slides 9-10)

Reviewed key technical delivery dates. November release development is now completed and deployed to pre-prod, including outstanding development on some internal reporting.

Some technical guides will be delivered later than scheduled due to internal resource constraints. It was raised that there was an incorrect configuration item in Pre-Prod – AEMO confirmed that it will be corrected in Pre-prod over the next few days.

Action AEMO to update incorrect configuration item (CT ACCURACY CLASS) in Pre-Prod

5. MSDR Focus Group Update – B. Miner (slides 11-12)

October's meeting focused on learnings from SIPF and progressed thinking around the upcoming MSDR data transition activities. Positive feedback was received from participants regarding AEMO's role in coordinating and providing governance around the SIPF BUT updates.

The MSDR FG saw value in Industry establishing a notional NEM daily MSDR update limit of 300-400k transactions per day. AEMO was asked to help in requesting plans, consolidation, and coordination activities. AEMO confirmed that they should be able to perform this role on behalf of Industry but that AEMO's systems would not be able to enforce the agreed daily limits, as the BUT is a 'self-serve' product.

AEMO stressed the importance of Participants focusing on MSDR Priority 1 field updates in the short to medium term.



It is worth noting that post the November MSDR FG meeting, the MSDR FG will only meet on an as-needs basis during the MSDR Data Transition period. Ongoing Industry engagement and updates is expected to occur via email and the Implementation Forum.

Next meeting scheduled for 21st November.

6. Industry Testing Approach – T. Grant (slides 13-16)

Wholesale refresh had an impact on retail which interrupted testing in pre-prod - system is now fully available. 2 listed defects have been closed - remaining issue being worked through via the MSDR Focus Group. Feedback to-date is that there won't be a requirement for additional validation for removal of meters CRs.

Next ITFG will be held in January

Now focusing on Planning for 2023 - Industry testing Approaches for IESS Initial Release and May will be presented at the next ITFG

7. Implementation Planning – C. Fleming (slides 17-18)

Final versions of MSDR go-live plan has been released. Reviewed changes in the latest versions as per the presentation in particular for 23rd November.

MSATS will still be available however there is a potential 5-hour DERR outage late morning on 23rd November, duration approx. 5 hours. Timing TBC

Action Go-live plan to be re-released when DERR outage times are confirmed

Question raised on timings in the Go-live plan ... Confirmed that timings are in Market Time (AEST)

Final version of Go-Live plan for CDR also released - Confirmed production deployment date of 2nd November for CDR APIs.

8. 2023 Release – G Minney (slides 19-24)

Presented draft milestones for IES March 2023.

Note: Data Model Release may include updated tables for SAPS settlement requirements

Presented Plan on a Page for the May 2023 release including Draft Milestones with consultation dates and indicative delivery dates.

Will confirm baselined dates at the next Implementation Forum meeting Will combine MSATS changes across all projects into a single MSATS Technical Specification.

Release will require updated aseXML schemas for B2M and B2B changes. There will be a single aseXML schema (r43) to address B2M and B2B changes for this release.

Timing and approach to transition plans to be addressed post procedures consultation.

Also presented Major & Minor Initiatives for 2023 Release 1 as per the presentation
