Action 2303-09: Shared Fusing

Paul Greenwood spoke to the issue and shared the process diagram. B2B-WG agreed that the CSV solution is an interim solution and future changes will be dependent on volumes of changes sent via the CSV. Paul suggested use of the NOMW as an option for notifying when an isolator has been installed for a metering installation. Paul Greenwood noted that codify in the Notes field of the NOMW could satisfy as interim solution. To assess potential future solutions, Paul Greenwood will prepare a draft ICF to enable solution discussions. Helen Vassos mentioned that the CSV will contain information when a MP finds the site has no shared fuse arrangement present.

AEMO is analysing the survey. David Woods suggested a third option about how to initially populate the Shared Isolation Point Flag in MSATS, Meghan Bibby (AEMO) asked that David Woods reach out to Gareth Morrah (AEMO) for this to be included in the MSDR Data Transition planning.

Action: Paul Greenwood will draft an ICF for potential future issues and share with the B2B-WG. Mark Riley offered to help with the ICF.

Action: David Woods to contact Gareth Morrah regarding the MSDR Data Transition approach for the Shared Isolation Point Flag.

Action: Meghan Bibby to ask Lenard Bull about 'NOMW' transaction, if a new field is added to the NOMW does it trigger a new schema.

Meghan Bibby noted that actions 2303-09 and 10 can be closed as they are now wrapped up in other actions.

Meghan Bibby noted that B2B minor amendment version 3.6.2 is with IEC for approval of final report and procedure changes and scheduled to be published on 12 July 2021.

Meghan Biibby also noted that B2B consultation version 3.7 is out for consultation with the Initial Stage submissions due by 6 July 2021.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION OR NOTING

2.1 B2B-WG recommendations for the inclusion of Notified Parties for coincident service orders - Meghan Bibby (AEMO)/Dino Ou (Endeavour Energy)

Discussion:

- IEC requested further analysis by B2B-WG.
- Simply Energy has excused itself from the meeting as Endeavour's proposal has fundamental issues and highlighted that any discussion should not progress at this stage as it may have competition protocol issues.
- Dino Ou mentioned there was some misunderstanding as there was no intention to suggest creating issues with the Competition Law and provided further explanation.
- Simply Energy suggested further steps prior to discussion of Endeavour's proposal.
- David Woods asked for clarification of nextn steps.
- AEMO's next steps will be to explore with their legal team options for progressing the coincident service order discussion following Simply Energy's concerns.

Actions:

 Discussion halted pending AEMO's discussions with their legal team about how to progress.

2.2 Pre-consultation survey on Notified Parties for coincident service orders - Meghan Bibby/Michelle Norris (AEMO)

Discussion:

- Meghan Bibby (AEMO) spoke to the item. Topic to be renamed as Coincident service orders across multiple service providers.
- Shaun Cupitt (Alinta Energy) spoke about the associated risks with the issue.
- Need to summarise the issue (coincident service orders across multiple service providers), come up with questions that look at risks, customer impacts and costs, magnitude (current, 18 months time, 3 to 5 years time), and ideas on how to tackle it.
- Mark Riley (AGL) suggested asking, if people undertake move out de-en's, remote deen's

 AEMO to rework the questions and recirculate, detail the issue at hand for people to discuss.
